About Citi Savvy

On Tuesday 11 July and Wednesday 12 July, 9am to 4pm, we are holding two career insight days in partnership with Citi Bank at their Canary Wharf offices in London. Students will participate in a series of workshops and find out what it is like to work in a bank.

Students will meet and work with pupils from a range of schools on tasks related to the finance industry, have the opportunity to quiz employees (from graduates to senior managers to directors) and have a tour of the building. This is a brilliant opportunity for students who are interested in learning about the financial sector and who do not have access to such opportunities.

Who can take part

Please nominate students who meet the following criteria for the Citi Savvy Insight Day:

- up to six students in Year 12
- predicted at least ABB
- have not taken part in a similar opportunity before
- highly motivated and interested in the opportunity
- *preferable but not essential: taking at least one STEM subject*

Citi Bank is keen to reach out to more female students, those who will be the first in their family to go to university, or those receiving free school meals.

How to nominate students

Please nominate up to six students for this opportunity, indicating on your booking form whether you would prefer the Tuesday 11, Wednesday 12, or have no particular preference. Please pass your completed form to your Future First Alumni Officer as soon as possible.

Once received, the students will have a telephone interview with a member of the Future First team to determine their suitability for the programme and their interest in the opportunity. Spaces are limited and dependent on a successful telephone interview.
