

Interview with adults at home

This is an opportunity to find out about the job or current role of one of the adults that lives with you at home. Below are ten questions you can ask. You could write notes about their answers on a separate piece of paper or you could record the interview as a video or voice recording.

Listen carefully to their answers and if you want to know more don't forget to prompt them or ask your own questions too. This interview will take about 20 minutes so make sure your adult has time to sit down and chat!

Interview questions

1. What is your current job or role (such as a parent or carer)?
2. Was this what you wanted to be when you were younger?
3. What was your favourite subject when you were in primary school? Why?
4. Can you tell me a bit about your job or role and what a typical day looks like?
5. How many (if any) different jobs have you had in the past and what were they?
6. How did you find out about your current job or one of the jobs in your past? How did you apply for it?
7. Did you need any qualifications to get your current job or one of the jobs in your past?
8. What skills do you need to have to be good at your current job or role?
9. What is your favourite thing about your current job or role? Why?
10. What are some of the challenges you face in your current job or role?

After the interview, have a think about the following questions yourself:

- What was the most interesting thing you found out about your adult at home?
- Do you have any of the same skills as your adult at home?
- Is there a job or pathway you are interested in for the future?
